Dear Fellow Believers and Friends,

January was a slow month for our ministry. Pastor Jim Grantham in Smiths Station, AL, had open heart surgery in December, and we were planning to spend a couple of weeks filling in for him. As it turned out, Tamatha was still having some physical problems, and we decided to stay in Greenville. It worked out well because Bro. Grantham recovered quickly and was already back in the pulpit.

Since we needed to stay in Greenville for the entire month, we were able to be in the services at our home church. When Tamatha was able to go to church, she taught the children's Sunday School class. I was also able to preach a couple of times at our home church. The children have enjoyed seeing and spending time with their friends and family in Greenville.

I have also used the time to work on our schedule. As you can see on the back, we are beginning to fill up the year. We are excited about the four tent revivals that are scheduled in Alabama, South Carolina, and South Dakota. We had three last year, and I have been praying that we would have at least six. If the Lord blesses and gives more, we would be thrilled. I am still working on scheduling some other tent revivals, so we should be able to report on where and when they will be next month.

We are also excited about the missions meeting in Jefferson, GA, and the revival meeting in Blackfoot, ID. We will stay at both churches for two weeks. We will spend the first week canvassing and knocking on doors. The second week we will have services. We love being able to stay two weeks at churches. It gives time to preach and minister, and it also provides time to fellowship and encourage God's people.

You will also notice several times that we are scheduled for Sunday and midweek services only. Some church planters prefer that we come for a week without doing a meeting of some kind. This allows us to minister in their regular services and provide some fellowship and encouragement during the week. In some areas, we may do some canvassing. In others, we will strengthen the believers. We just make ourselves available to do whatever the pastors feel is best for his church and family.

Tamatha underwent some tests a few weeks ago. They were some routine tests recommended because she turned forty last year. They came back with good results. She is also going through some tests related to her Crohn's disease. She had been doing well for nearly two years after starting a diet specifically for Crohn's disease. However, it seems that it has flared up again. We will know for sure once the tests are done in February. After her surgery in 2007, we followed the physician's advice and used medication. When the Crohn's flared in 2011, she started the diet. Since neither the medication nor diet have worked completely, we are not sure what to do. Pray for the Lord's direction concerning Tamatha's health.

We are praying that some expenses incurred last year will be paid off. Those expenses include some truck and trailer repairs and also fuel costs. Some churches have helped by sending offerings, but we still need to pay for the remainder of those expenses. If the Lord should lead you to help with those costs, we certainly would appreciate it.
