Many people do not understand how needful it is to have someone to fill in when the missionary needs to be away for rest or for any other need. Often, there is no one around who can conduct the services and preach. Someone in a ministry like ours is a great help. While it is our desire to preach revivals and not fill in all the time, we are glad to do it as needed. We enjoyed a great time in Ogden, UT.

As I mentioned last month, while in Ogden the floor of the main slide-out in our trailer broke. Because the repairs would take several weeks, we reluctantly canceled our trip to Arizona. We were looking forward to seeing and laboring with our friends there, but since we were only planning on being in Arizona for two weeks, there would not be enough time to do the repairs. After getting a temporary repair done, we headed towards Alabama.

On the way back east, we stopped in Central City, Nebraska, and attended Central City Baptist Church. We enjoyed meeting Pastor Jamie Davis and the people of the church. We were glad to be in both services. On Wednesday, we stopped in Jackson, TN, and attended Gospel Light Baptist Church. The pastor and the church people welcomed us kindly and allowed me to present our work. In spite of the trailer problem, we were glad we could meet the people of these churches.

We made plans to have the trailer repaired at a shop in Cullman, AL. Pastor Keith Whitley allowed us to use the missionary apartment of Victory Baptist Church while the trailer was in the shop. This would enable us to keep our meetings that we had scheduled in Tennessee and Alabama. We are very thankful for the kindness and hospitality of the people of Victory as we literally moved in on them. The trailer repairs took three weeks, but thankfully the cost was less than we expected.
