Dear Fellow Believers and Friends,

We spent the month of March in western North Carolina. We had hoped to visit some more of our supporting churches throughout central North Carolina and also in South Carolina, but the situation with our trailer did not allow us to travel. By the middle of March, we had our trailer back, but we could not travel much in it. The damage could not be fixed by the dealer, and the manufacturer cannot repair it until September. As a result, we began to look at trading ours in for a newer trailer. We found one but needed some help to make the down payment.

After learning our situation, I sent a letter to 40 pastors explaining the situation and asking if they and their church could help us with the down payment. Our goal was to have the money so we could purchase the new trailer by the end of March. Unfortunately, only one pastor responded to us. We are grateful for Pastor Darren White and Emmanuel Baptist Church in Valley, AL, for their help. Even though the letter did not receive much response, all is not lost. Pastor Keith Linzy and Morning Star Baptist Church in Shelby, NC, gave a large offering for the down payment. In addition, two churches near Shelby gave us offerings when we dropped in for a service. Lighthouse Baptist Church in Blacksburg, SC, and Love Valley Baptist Church in Kings Mountain were very kind to us. So far, we have \$1800 towards our down payment. The dealer is asking for a minimum of \$5,000, so we need God to help in a mighty way.

The repair shop that discovered the damage to our trailer said that we could take it on short trips, but they would not advise any long trips. That means we can make our trips to Alabama and Georgia, but we must have a new trailer by the end of May in order to make our trips to Michigan, South Dakota, and so forth. It seems an impossible task to see accomplished, especially after the lack of response to the letter that we sent out in March. We live month to month with just enough to get by. We do not have any left over to save for future expenses. That is not meant as a complaint, but just explaining the realities. In spite of what seems impossible, we are trusting the Lord that we will have what we need to purchase the new trailer by the end of May. We keep reminding ourselves of Luke 1:37, "For with God nothing shall be impossible." Please pray that this need for a new trailer will be met by the end of May.

Unfortunately, as we mentioned last month, some independent Baptists have changed in their music. We are always disappointed in that, but we are really excited when we meet some good churches that are still singing and preaching right.
