Dear Fellow Believers and Friends,

In this prayer letter, I will give you some information about the work done on our trailer in January. I will also give a synopsis of our ministry for 2016 and also preview our plans for 2017.

We spent January in Shelby, NC, in the mission house of Morning Star Baptist Church. We visited a few churches in the area, but spent most of our time in the services at Morning Star. We certainly appreciate the church allowing us to use the mission house again. It was very helpful while we were out of our home.

In early January, I took our trailer to Shipshewana, IN. That is the headquarters for the company that manufactured our trailer. As you may remember, the outside wall had cracked, and no local RV repair shop could fix it. We tried to trade the trailer, but since no one would accept it as a trade-in, we scheduled the repairs in Indiana. They were very efficient in their work and finished it in a little over two weeks. They reinforced the trailer on the top and sides and redid the outside walls, as well as replacing the two doors. The trailer looks very nice now. They expect the repairs to last for a while, and we certainly hope they do. But then again most RV's are not pulled 20,000-30,000 miles a year and lived in every day of the year. The repairs cost just under \$6,000. It also cost \$1,000 in fuel and other expenses to get the trailer to Indiana and back. We had some money remaining from what we had raised for the trailer last year, and others have given this year, but we still need to pay off these repair bills. We are trusting the Lord to provide what is needed.

In spite of a late start due to the trailer being in the shop at the first of the year, and also having to return to the southeast because of the death of my dad, we still had a fairly busy year. We traveled around 24,000 miles and labored in 11 states and 28 churches. Included in that were 5 tent revivals in AL, SC, MI, and SD. We had plans to go to MT, UT, and AZ, but were unable to return west after my dad's death. We had a great time in each place that we labored and certainly appreciate every pastor allowing us to be with them and their church.

This year we are excited about what lies ahead. We had considered heading to AZ in March, but decided it would be more cost efficient to go there upon leaving the Midwest. As you can see on the back, we have scheduled some services since last month. We have others that we are in contact with and are awaiting final confirmation. We will have tent revivals and other services in AL, GA, and SC, during the spring. We then will head to VA and MI before arriving in the Dakotas and NE for the remainder of the summer. We are hoping also to minister in MT, UT, and AZ, before heading back

We also lost four supporters, but the Lord replaced some of that with two new supporters. Our current monthly support is around \$1,200. Our expenses are around \$3,000, so the Lord supplies the other \$2,000 through church offerings and offerings through the mail. We appreciate every church and family that enables us to serve the Lord.

We have much to do this year. Please pray that we will be faithful to accomplish all that we can for the Lord.
