Dear Fellow Believers and Friends,

During May we continued our time in the Southeast as we labored in Georgia and Alabama. The Lord gave us a good tent revival and good services in the churches where we ministered. At the end of the month we switched out school books and headed to Conway, SC, for our third tent revival of the year.

We began the month in Ellenwood, GA, at Berean Baptist Church. We met Pastor Alan Sinclair in Alabama where his church participated in the tent revival in Cullman the past two years along with two other churches. When he moved to Georgia, he scheduled us for a tent revival at his new church. Being south of Atlanta, there were more people to contact than in some places where we have labored. The church ordered 3,000 invitations to distribute. It was not hard to give them all out. Rain hindered our going out a couple of times, but we still were able to distribute them all. We canvassed houses in the mornings and evenings. Several church people came to the visitation, and the work was accomplished.

Several visitors came during the week. One man came forward and made a profession of salvation. Others seemed to get help with other things throughout the week. We enjoyed good services under the tent every night. Our children made some new friends, and we had a great time at Ellenwood, GA, with the people of Berean Baptist Church.

From Ellenwood, we headed to central Alabama and parked at Victory Baptist Church in Cullman pastored by Keith Whitley. I taught Sunday School and preached on Wednesday night, and we enjoyed good fellowship throughout the week.

While in Cullman, we drove up to Lexington, AL, to be with the people of Grassy Baptist Church. The church has supported us for several years, but we had not been with them in five years. When I called Pastor Stanley Hargett and told him that we were planning on being in the service, he asked me to preach. We enjoyed being with the people of Grassy and ministering with them.

Our final stop in May was with Pastor Jeff Mims and the people of Lifegate Baptist Church in Arab, AL. We have been in several services at Lifegate over the years, but this was our first opportunity to labor with them. Bro. Mims asked us to help with visitation, and we were glad to do so. We went out each morning, and Bro. Mims and some church people came in the evenings to go with us. We reached several homes during the week and were excited to meet some people who had just moved into the area. One lady that I talked to had just moved to Arab along with her husband and children. She attended a Bible college in Florida, and she and her husband have a good testimony. They have been attending a church in a neighboring city, but she said it would be better if they went to one closer. We are praying that they will start attending Lifegate. We closed out our time in Alabama and at Lifegate as I preached both services
