It gives the children a chance to be with other children and also to see how much they have learned each year. They always do well, so hopefully that means that Tamatha and I are doing a good job of teaching them. This year was special because it was William's last set of achievement tests. Next year he will take college entrance exams as he finishes high school. The children enjoyed a good week as they did the tests, and Tamatha and I were able to get some other work accomplished as well.

The Sunday before the tests, we were able to visit one of our former supporting churches. New Life Baptist Church in Greer supported us for several years but had to drop many missionaries last year as the church lost members. The new pastor, Paul Pendell, contacted us earlier this year and explained what had happened. It was a great blessing to meet Bro. Pendell and to hear of their desire to support us again when possible. We were pleasantly surprised to see my uncle Bennie Poole at New Life that morning.
