We really enjoyed our time with the Howards and the people of Pleasantview Baptist Church.

Our final Sunday in Arizona was at Lighthouse Baptist Church in Avondale, just outside of Phoenix. We enjoyed hearing Bro. Manuel teach Sunday School and preach the morning service and also hearing his daughters sing. That night I had the privilege of preaching. We enjoyed seeing the Manuels again and seeing firsthand what God is doing through them in Avondale.

From Arizona, we stopped over in Santa Fe, NM, to renew our acquaintance with the Chris Rogers family. We had met them while they were raising support, but had not seen them since they moved to New Mexico. We enjoyed their Thursday night service and being able to see what the Lord is doing through them in Santa Fe.

Our last stop in October was in Abilene, TX, with Pastor Dale Morrison and the people of Victory Baptist Church. Our pastor friend in Alabama, Keith Whitley, is good friends with Bro. Morrison and told us about the church. We were thrilled to meet them, and I had the privilege of preaching for the first time in Texas at Victory Baptist Church. Bro. Morrison is excited about what the Lord is doing in Abilene and wants to hold a tent revival. The Lord willing, we are planning to do so next fall.
