I even borrowed a cap and gown from Tabernacle Baptist College to wear during the service. William picked the congregational songs for the service, and we enjoyed singing them and listening to the specials. Then I preached a message entitled, "What Will You Do Now?" I briefly looked at five men, some who made bad decisions and some who made good decisions, and challenged William and all of us to continually make decisions that please the Lord. After I awarded William his diploma, we had a great time of fellowship in our fellowship hall. We appreciate all of the hard work that the ladies in our church did to help with this service and the fellowship time afterwards. It was a fantastic night.
