Dear Fellow Believers and Friends,

We enjoyed a busy and exciting month of June. I will give more details about our services throughout the letter, but let me give a synopsis of how we spent the month of June. We closed out our meeting in Jefferson, GA, on the 1st. On the 2nd, we pulled the trailer to Greenville, ate dinner with Tamatha's parents, and drove four hours to Conway, SC. After the Sunday night service in Conway, we traveled back to Greenville because we had so much to do. We got our new schoolbooks together during the week and on Saturday headed to Virginia. We spent a week and a half in three churches and then headed to South Dakota, closing out the month in Elk Point, SD. Within the month we traveled and preached from the coast of South Carolina to southeastern South Dakota and enjoyed every minute of it.

God was so gracious to meet our needs throughout the month. Occasionally, some will ask about our support and if any new churches have taken us on for support. Of course, we are not opposed to regular support, if the Lord so leads, but most of the time, He chooses to supply our needs in unusual, unexpected ways. We went into this ministry six years ago just trusting the Lord to meet our daily needs. He has done so through churches and individuals. We want to keep trusting the Lord. He has been faithful in the past and will continue to be faithful now and in the future. Why should we worry?

Let me give you an example of how the Lord supplied our need of fuel money as we traveled across the United States. In April, I sent a letter to over twenty pastors who receive our NewsLetter, but whose church does not currently support us. I asked them if they would consider taking up an offering to help us with the fuel costs as we headed across the country. By June, when it came time to leave for South Dakota, not one of those pastors had responded. I did not expect all of them to help us, but I did not expect to receive no response from any of them.

But the Lord had a different way of supplying our needs. The fuel bill to get from Virginia to South Dakota was going to be \$500. As of the third week of June, all of our regular bills were paid, but we still did not have the extra money for the fuel costs. To add to our "problem," I had not been able to schedule anything for June 17th. We decided to drop in on a couple of churches in Southwest Virginia, within driving distance of Cedar Bluff. This was how the Lord would meet our fuel money needs. Pastor Scott Suttle asked me to preach the night of the 17th. On the 20th, we dropped in at Calvary Baptist in Clintwood, VA. Pastor Clifton Cauthorne asked me to preach that night. Those two offerings provided \$400 of the \$500 that we needed. We were still \$100 short but headed on to South Dakota. When we arrived in Elk Point, SD, my dad called to say that Richard and Shirley Hughes had mailed in \$100. God provided the exact amount of money we needed to get to South Dakota in ways that I could never have imagined. Praise the LORD!

In addition to the above offerings the Lord provided for us through our regular supporting churches, the churches where I preached, and also special gifts from Jerry Skelton Jr. and Jeffrey Jacques. Words cannot express our thanks to you for enabling us to preach the Gospel across the United States.
