We are still planning on entering a joint tent ministry with Evangelist Van Billingsley. Bro. Van is raising support right now, so our plans are to try to hold tent meetings next year. We also need to raise some more support and hope to do so in early 2013. There are many places that we could have the tent meetings, and we are looking forward to preaching under the tent next year.

This school year is rapidly moving along. We finished the third quarter at the end of February. The children are excited about having some time off during the summer, as well as their teachers—Mom and Dad.

Silas celebrated his 6<sup>th</sup> birthday on February 11<sup>th</sup> with family and friends. He also lost his first tooth a couple of weeks later. Our children are all getting older—fast. William turns 12 this year, Nowelle 11, and Wesley Peter 9.
