I gave a brief synopsis of how we found our truck last month. I will do the same about the trailer. Tamatha had spent several months looking at many different makes and models. One kind that she really liked was no longer made by the manufacturer. We decided to wait to make a purchase until after an RV trade show in Greenville. While at the show, we saw many trailers, but not one that would really work for us. We then went to a section reserved for a dealer that we had been to many times for service on our old trailer. While talking with them, we also met a representative of Open Range. They had made the trailer that Tamatha really liked. He mentioned that they had one at the factory in Indiana that they were refurbishing, and then said, "We can make you the deal of a lifetime." I do not know if that statement is true, but it was a good deal—the best trailer for us at a very good price. Working through our local dealer, we were able to get the trailer at the end of March.
