Dear Fellow Believers and Friends,

We spent March continuing to wait on the repairs to our trailer. As I mentioned last month, what was originally thought to be a two-week job turned into a month-long job and counting. After six weeks, our trailer was finally finished. The delay caused us to miss the first week of our time in Conway, and also limited us in getting completely back on the road. I will give the full details of all the work that was done on our trailer next month.

The delay did allow us to see some more pastors and churches in the Greenville area that we have not seen for several years. Among those were Pastor Jeremy Chism at Bethany Baptist Church in Travelers Rest, SC, and Pastor Daniel Waters at Good News Baptist Church in Greer, SC. We dropped in both of these churches on Sunday mornings, and the pastors and people were very receptive and kind to us. Both men allowed us to give an update of our ministry. We told them what the Lord allowed us to do in 2014, and the plans He has allowed us to make for 2015. We certainly appreciate the kindness of these two pastors and churches.

One Sunday night we visited Pastor Jim Carrigan and the people of Freedom Baptist Church in Greenville, SC. Freedom has supported us since we began this ministry over 9 years ago. In fact, they were the first church after our home church to support us. My dad is a member of the church, and I worked as Youth Director there back in the early 1990's. It was a great blessing to report to the church where we had been throughout 2014 and to let them know where the Lord was having us serve in 2015. We enjoyed seeing many friends that we have known for years at Freedom Baptist Church.

Although we could not make it to Conway for the first week of fellowship and canvassing because our trailer was still in the shop, we were determined to make it for the week of tent revival. For most of our meetings we try to go for two weeks. This allows us to invite people to the meeting and also provides time for fellowship with the church planter and his family and also other people in the church. The encouragement of God's people through fellowship is a big part of our ministry, but it is hard to do school, have some quality fellowship time, and have a revival meeting all in the same week. This time we had no choice. The Kunkle family allowed us to use their motor home for the week and also put us in an RV park. We certainly appreciate their kindness in allowing us to use their motor home.

The weather did not cooperate for the tent revival. It rained a lot while we were there and the ground was over saturated with water. We were able to have two services
