Dear Fellow Believers and Friends,

We spent the month of February continuing to visit supporting churches, meeting new pastors at churches where we have been before, working on our schedule for the remainder of the year, and getting some service done on our truck and trailer. We enjoyed being in each church, meeting new people, and seeing friends that we have made in the past. We also have been very anxious to return to the road and begin our meetings and labor for the year.

The first Sunday of February we drove to Seneca, SC, to be with Pastor Shawn Street and the people of Old Hepsibah Baptist Church. Tamatha met Bro. Street while she was in the hospital last year. She told him about our ministry, and he said to drop by when we had a chance. I described our ministry both during Sunday School and the morning service, and Tamatha and the children sang. Bro. Street and the people responded very kindly to us. We enjoyed meeting the people of Old Hepsibah Baptist Church.

Our next few services were spent meeting new pastors at churches in Pickens, Taylors, and Greenville. We had ministered in several of these churches in the past and wanted to meet these men. All of them were very kind to us, and many allowed us to update the church on what we have been doing since we were last there. We appreciate the kindness of each of these churches.

In between meeting these new pastors, we drove to Laurens, SC, on February 15. Bro. Jerry Nye had just moved to Laurens a few months ago to try to rebuild Faith Baptist Church. Faith Baptist Church has a great heritage. John Waters started the church and pastored it for many years. The last several years, the church has dwindled in size and was on the brink of closing. Bro. Nye and his wife began a church rescue ministry a few years ago and came to help Faith. Bro. Nye asked me to preach the afternoon service. I enjoyed doing so. We were glad to be in the services at Faith in Laurens and look forward to helping there in the future, as the Lord leads.

When our truck had some problems at the end of 2013, we had to replace three fuel injectors. The mechanic said that in about a year the others would need to be replaced. That year, of course, has come and gone. We took the truck to the shop to replace the other injectors, hoping that some would last a bit longer. Unfortunately, all were worn out. Fuel injectors are not cheap, so by the time everything was done, our bill was over \$2000. That is not the kind of bill you want to get, but big trucks cost a lot to maintain, and we need a big truck to pull the trailer so we can live on the road.

We also took the trailer in for some repairs. A wall in the back had separated from the frame. While preparing to fix the wall, the men noticed that our steel beams under the trailer were cracking. What started as a two-week job turned into a four-week job and counting. It necessitated cutting a week out of our Conway meeting and traveling there for the week of the tent revival without our trailer. Thankfully, our homeowners insurance has covered some, and depending on the final cost, possibly all of this repair. Now, the repair shop is estimating that our trailer will be ready by the end of March.
